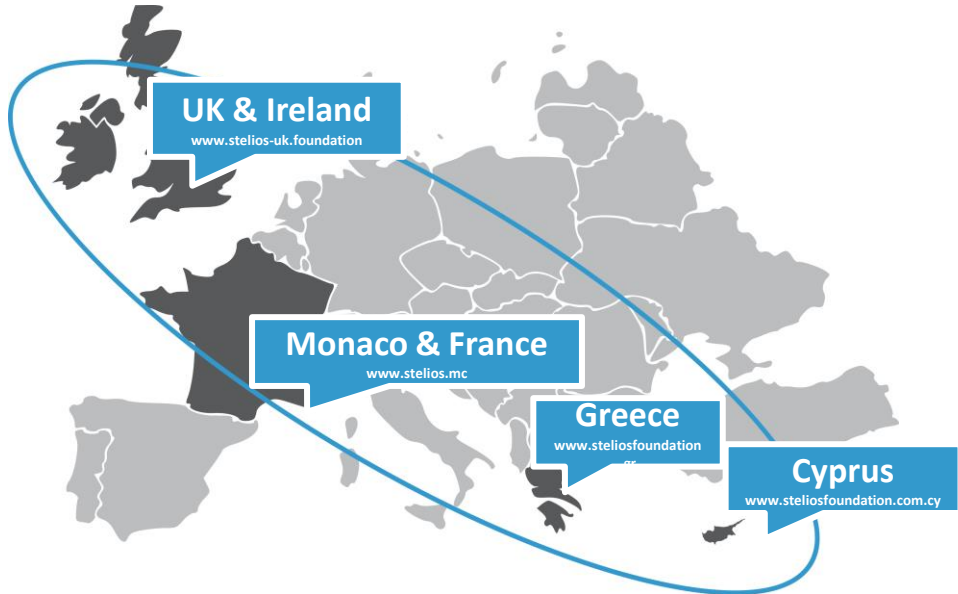

His maternal grandmother Cleo Missirlis-Potsos was born in the village of Lania. The Foundation owns properties in these communities and continues to support both areas financially.

Other charitable work in Cyprus

Operating since 2013 from 12 distribution points in Cyprus and Greece. The Foundation has handed out more than **36 million snacks to date to people in need in Cyprus & Greece.**



The Foundation supports Olympic Cypriot sailor Pavlos Kontides. November 2022 crowned European Champion Hyeres Laser European Championship.



Sir Stelios founded the Cyprus Marine Environment Protection Association (cymepa.org.cy) in 1992. The Foundation continues to support the organisation and donated €30k in March 2022 towards the celebration of 30 years of commitment to safer & cleaner seas.

- Instead, donations were given to front line health workers in the Greek Cypriots and the Turkish Cypriot communities.

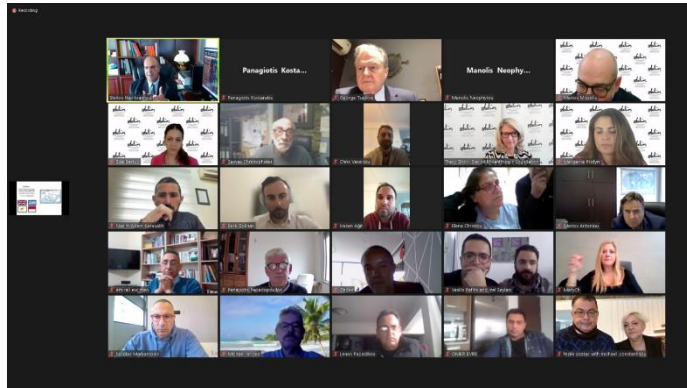


Stelios bi-communal Awards Cyprus

- Started in 2009.
- 4,390,000 million euros (including this year's 200k euros) has been awarded to date.
- The awards encourage bi-communal cooperation between Greek Cypriots and Turkish Cypriots to promote lasting peace on the island.
- 2019 last physical ceremony.
- 2020 & 2021 no awards due to the pandemic.
- 2022 and 2023 started again with the new norm via zoom.
- 2024 hybrid ceremony at Markou Drakou and via zoom
